It is understood that the medication is given solely at the request of, and as an accommodation to, the undersigned parent(s) or guardian(s). The undersigned parent(s) or guardian(s) hereby agree(s) to release the Douglas County School District Re. 1 and its personnel from any and all claim(s) which they now have or may hereafter have arising out of the release of the medication to the student.

A new Student Medication Request and Release Agreement form must be completed for each medication change and each school year.
